"OLD LOVE," Norm Foster's sparkling and witty look at love the second time around follows the rollercoaster romance of Bud, a salesman, and Molly, his former boss' wife. After years of 'doing the right thing', they both find themselves single and wrestling with who they truly are, what they need in a relationship and where the future will lead them. Self-image, physical desire, loneliness, fear and hidden dreams are all in the cards and tackled through laughter, honesty, anger and hope with hilarious and heart-warming results.

"We're all looking forward to rehearsals", said Heather Dick, Artistic Director. "OLD LOVE is a delightfully warm and funny story so we're expecting that the rehearsal hall will be filled with laughter and surprises."

Genie-nominated Marianne McIsaac directs the production. Marianne's extensive stage and screen career includes performances in Norman Lear's "THE BAXTERS", the U.S. soap opera "HIGH HOPES" and "CRIMES OF THE HEART" as Lenny. She was invited to guest lecture at the Ryerson University Theatre School in 1996 and continues to teach acting part-time. For the Ryerson Theatre Company she has directed productions of "THE LARAMIE PROJECT", "THE HOUSE OF BERNARDA ALBA" and all six of George F. Walker's one-act plays from "Suburban Motel."

"OLD LOVE" is a two-actor tour de force. HEATHER DICK, Sirius Theatrical Company's Artistic Director, co-stars as Molly Graham and six other characters. She has worked across Canada as both an actor and a director and last year wrote and directed the Company's War of 1812 celebration, "FORGOTTEN VOICES", which was performed in parks and heritage sites in south Etobicoke in July. Favourite acting roles include Marjorie in the one-woman show "JEWEL" (Sirius Theatrical Co.), Sally in "TALLEY'S FOLLY" (Sudbury Theatre Centre), and Doris in "SAME TIME NEXT YEAR" (Kawartha Summer Theatre).

Directing credits include: "MAIL-ORDER ANNIE" (Sirius Theatrical Co.), "LA SANTE C'EST PAS SORCIER" (Waterwood Prods., Ontario Tour) and "THE ART OF LISTENING" (Southern Mirrors Productions, Toronto Fringe). Heather founded the Sirius Theatrical Company in 1989 and has been the company's Artistic Director ever since.

NICHOLAS RICE will play Bud and two other characters. His favorite theatre credits include "CAROLINE, OR CHANGE" (Acting Up Stage Co./ Obsidian Theatre), "THE PRICE" (Manitoba Theatre Centre), "ANGELS IN AMERICA" (Winnipeg Jewish Theatre), and "OLIVER!" (Port Hope). On film, Nicholas is best known as Kirstie Alley's toupée-wearing date in "LOOK WHO'S TALKING". He will perform this summer in Prescott in "TWO GENTS OF VERONA" and "THE TEMPEST".

Daina Luszczek will design the costumes. She worked on costumes for the Company's production of "FORGOTTEN VOICES" last summer and was also an Assistant Stage Manager. Over the years, she has designed costumes for numerous productions for Theatre Etobicoke and other community theatres.

Arber Makri, the multi-talented Designer for "FORGOTTEN VOICES", will again design both set and props for "OLD LOVE".

"I'm thrilled that both Daina and Arber are coming back to work with us", said Heather Dick. "They are extremely creative artists who bring something special to every show they work on."

In addition to staging several productions each year, the Sirius Theatrical Company also offers acting workshops and classes and provides training for both the community and aspiring professional performers. They are members of The Toronto Alliance for the Performing Arts (TAPA), the Toronto Association of Acting Studios (TAAS), the Mississauga Arts Council, Arts Etobicoke and Lakeshore Arts.
